Since October 2021, Carla Meyer-Massetti is an Assistant Professor of Clinical Pharmacy in the Department of General Internal Medicine at Inselspital.

She has studied Pharmacy in Basel, followed by a specialization in Hospital Pharmacy and a joint PhD at the University of California San Francisco and the University of Basel.

After working for the Swiss Patient Safety Foundation and as a medication safety specialist in different institutions, she has joined the University of Bern in 2020, contributing as a senior lecturer at the Institute of Primary Health Care BIHAM to the new master of Pharmacy curriculum.

Her research group, consisting of Ursina Wernli, Nicole Schönenberger and Aljoscha Goetschi - three PhD students with a degree in pharmacy - focuses on improving medication safety in acute and long-term care, specifically addressing elderly patients and transition of care. The whole group is also actively involved in clinical work and teaching.
